Off-Licence

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Crimson Badger Brewing Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **Units A, C & D, 141 Glenda Drive, Frankton, Queenstown**, and known as "**CRIMSON BADGER BREWING**" to any person for consumption off the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day:
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 5.00pm

- c) The licensee must ensure that alcohol is not delivered to any buyer (or to any other person on the buyer's behalf) before 6.00am or after 11.00pm on any day.
- d) Drinking water must be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free, as a sample, on the premises.
- e) The entire premises is designated as **supervised**, in accordance with the plans of the licensed area submitted 11 April 2025.
- f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed: display of appropriate signs detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons, identification of minors.
- g) According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 the premises is assigned the fees category: **Medium Other premises not otherwise specified (Manufacturer)**.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) Until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
